### 2025 Scholarship Application

**SCHOLARSHIP AWARD** is a \$4000.00 scholarship awarded by the National Grand Chapter, O.E.S. National Education Department. The scholarship is awarded to applicants who exemplify academic performance, leadership potential, endorsement from OES or Masonic relative/sponsor and personal essay. \$1,000.00 of the scholarship award will be paid directly to the college or university each year of attendance for a maximum of four years.

#### SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a graduating high school student in the class of 2025.
- Applicants must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Applicants must provide an official high school transcript in a sealed envelope
- Applicants must submit a copy of the letter of acceptance from the college or university you plan to attend in the upcoming academic semester/schoolyear.
- Applicants must submit a letter of endorsement from an OES or Masonic relative or sponsor
- Applicants must submit a 300-word maximum personal essay (12-point font) indicating "Why do you
  deserve this scholarship and how will this scholarship impact your future?"
- Applicants must complete and submit all supporting documents (transcript, letter of acceptance, letter
  of OES/Masonic endorsement and personal essay) to the Worthy Grand Matron of the local Grand
  Chapter for final signature approval. The Scholarship Application along with supporting documents
  (transcript, letter of acceptance, letter of OES/Masonic endorsement and personal essay) should be

#### **SCHOLARSHIP TIMELINE**

- Applications with supporting documents (transcript, letter of acceptance, letter of OES/Masonic endorsement and personal essay) are due (postmarked) by June 1, 2025
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by July 1, 2025
- Awarded applicant will provide a graduation picture or photograph by July 15, 2025
- Awarded applicant will be announced during the Education Night Program on August 8, 2025 in Norfolk, Virginia.
