SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- *Applicants must be a graduating high school student in the class of 2026.*
- *Applicants must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher*
- *Applicants must provide an official high school transcript in a sealed envelope*
- *Applicants must submit a copy of the letter of acceptance from the college or university you plan to attend in the upcoming 2026 academic semester/school year.*
- *Applicants must submit a letter of endorsement from an OES or Masonic relative or sponsor*
- *Applicants must submit a brief 100-word personal essay (12-point font) indicating "Why do you deserve this scholarship and how this scholarship will impact your future?"*
- *Applicants must provide a school picture (academic / headshot), which will be shared and highlighted during the scholarship program*
- *Applicants must complete and submit all supporting documents (transcript, letter of acceptance, letter of OES/Masonic endorsement and personal essay) to the Worthy Grand Matron of the local Grand Chapter for final signature approval.
